Within this new role, you will be supporting women impacted by gambling wherever they are on their journey to promote choice, voice and change.

This role will involve working directly with women to provide access to care and support by creating psychologically safe spaces and fostering connection. The role will connect and support women throughout England who are impacted by gambling.

Job Purpose

This role will:

- Create psychologically safe spaces where women feel comfortable to connect, learn and grow
- Provide individual care tailored to the needs of the woman
- Encourage co-production and consultation with our women's community
- Co-ordinate activities reflective of the needs of our women
- Increase our engagement with women impacted by gambling and support services both within and outside of the gambling recovery space
- Support women to activate their rights, access advocacy services and pathways and address systemic barriers.

Key Responsibilities

- Coordinate and facilitate in-person monthly online spaces to support women affected by gambling throughout England and uphold a welcoming and inclusive environment that will ensure psychological safety for women.
- Deliver practical support and interventions related to gambling, mental health and overall well-being for women to ensure they can achieve the best outcomes.
- Develop honest and open relationships with our community that foster trust.
- Advocate for women's rights and access to services within the community. Provide information, referrals, and support connecting women with appropriate community resources and services.
- Use our training to develop additional skills to support and respond appropriately to our community who have experienced trauma.
- Champion best practice in providing support to women through a trauma-informed lens. Engage in ongoing professional development activities to enhance skills and knowledge relevant to the role.
- Work with people in our community with a wide range of experiences and cultural backgrounds with dignity, respect and kindness.
- Work as part of a team with a range of experiences and knowledge to the benefit of our community.
